- 1. The Board of Trustees of the Township of Lyons held its Regular Board Meeting on Tuesday, January 11, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in the Town Hall, 6404 Joliet Road, Countryside, Illinois 60525 and via conference call due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.
- 2. Supervisor Getty called the Meeting to order at 6:04 p.m.
