Mental Health Commission Trustee Porfirio reported that Executive Director Ron Melka will be conducting a Mental Health First Aid Training for Public Safety / Police Officers on February 10, 2022 and that on March 16, 2022 Executive Director Melka will be training Fire Fighters and EMS. Trustee Porfirio commented that all respective Township of Lyons departments have been invited to attend.
- 17. Trustee Porfirio also stated that on January 20, 2022 President Tony Przeklasa, Vice-President Rev. Clemmons, Treasurer Sophia Mallis, Executive Director Melka, and Administrative Assistant Jazmin Lopez met with Superintendent Dr. William Toulios, and Principal Brandon Cotter of Argo High School to discuss the behavioral health needs of the students there and how the Lyons Township Mental Health Commission community agencies can provide assistance.
- 18. Special Police Protection Trustee Anderson reported that forty-one officers had provided 180 hours of additional patrols during the period of December 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021 for the unincorporated areas of the Township of Lyons.
