6 the Annual Town Meeting that's held once a year, that
7 will be at 7:00 p.m.

10 Meeting of the Township of Lyons to order.

13 to come up to the podium and lead us in the Pledge of
14 Allegiance.

2 For many years now the Township has conducted
3 a Summer Youth Work Program, placing individuals
4 throughout the township at different governments and
5 non-for-profit agencies, oftentimes as their first
6 place of employment. We'd like to continue that this
7 calendar year.

12 this account. It only had a balance of \$2,945.09.

13 And also with BMO Harris Bank, the second
14 account we're looking to close is with Byline. This
15 account had a dollar amount of \$58,033.74. We're
16 looking to move both of those accounts to First
17 Midwest. We've had a relationship with their
18 Government Affairs Team for quite some time. And
19 we're looking to open up new accounts with that
20 institution.

6 Just to note, this is a partnership that was
7 started by Supervisor Mundy, if I remember correctly.
8 It has been a success. It moves from location to
9 location, but each time it gathers wide attendance
10 from people from the township, and we definitely want
11 to continue it.

13 think of a better thing to give money to than to feed
14 the poor. That's just a humanitarian thing. Thank
15 you.

7 We have 5-J. This is approval of the 2022
8 and 2023 Road District Budget and Appropriation
9 Ordinance. This was previously approved for hanging
10 for 30 days. The notice for our hearing was published
11 in the newspaper and posted. We conducted a budget
12 hearing, public budget hearing at 5:30 p.m. today
13 where it was also approved. And we are looking to
14 have final approval by the Town Board at this time.

15 TRUSTEE KELLY: I'll make that motion.

16 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Trustee Kelly.

17 Is there a second?

13 Road District Budget, this was previously approved for
14 hanging by the Town Board for 30 days. Notice for the
15 public hearing was published in the newspaper as well
16 as posted at the Township Hall. The public hearing
17 was held. It was approved at the public hearing. And
18 we are looking for final approval from the Town Board
19 at this time.

20 TRUSTEE ANDERSON: I'll make that motion.

5 CLERK HOFFENBERG: Trustee Anderson?

6 TRUSTEE ANDERSON: Aye.

7 CLERK HOFFENBERG: Trustee Porfirio?

9 CLERK HOFFENBERG: Trustee McDonald?

10 TRUSTEE MCDONALD: Aye.

13 CLERK HOFFENBERG: Supervisor Getty?

14 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Yes.

15 It is approved. Thank you very much.

16 CLERK HOFFENBERG: Very quickly, I just want
17 to mention that we had a very successful paper shred
18 event back on March 19th. It seemed like residents
19 from all of our communities tended to come out. It
20 was great. We will look forward to hosting future
21 events that are similar in nature.

22 We also have quick reminder, on April 28th
23 from 10 to 2, we will have a Secretary of State mobile
24 ID event at the Township. Appointments are filling up

1 fast, if you need to renew your driver's license.

2 TRUSTEE KELLY: What does that entail? Is it
3 just renewal of the driver's license?

4 CLERK HOFFENBERG: Renewal of driver's
5 license, renewal of license plate. You can't get a
6 brand new license or a brand new, you know, ID. But
7 you can renew things at the event. The Secretary of
8 State's office keeps kind of kicking the date by which
9 you have to renew. So this is a great opportunity for
10 township residents to come out. It's close, it's
11 local, hopefully it will be quick.

12 TRUSTEE MCDONALD: And are there people from
13 Social Security there to give advice and tell people
14 what to do?

15 CLERK HOFFENBERG: From the Secretary of
16 State's office, yes.

17 And Michael Frerichs, the treasurer for the
18 State of Illinois, his office sends a representative
19 as well so they can do some I-Cash searches for people
20 as well. So it's a nice opportunity.

21 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Are appointments required?

22 CLERK HOFFENBERG: They're not required,
23 they're suggested. We didn't take appointments once
24 and it was kind of a big backup.

1 TRUSTEE MCDONALD: A free-for-all.

2 CLERK HOFFENBERG: It was a bit of a
3 free-for-all. It's much more organized if we have
4 appointments, and we tend to prioritize those who come
5 in who have called ahead to reserve a time.

6 Then last but not least, anyone who's serving
7 on a board or any sort of public entity, just a quick
8 reminder, your statement of economic interest is due
9 on May 1st. So get that in. And that's it for my
10 report.

11 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Thank you very much,
12 Clerk.

13 At this time we move on to the Finance
14 Committee, Trustee Porfirio.

15 TRUSTEE PORFIRIO: Supervisor, trustees, I've
