15 we have our Statement of Economic Interest filing
16 deadline of May 1, 2023.

17 We also have a couple of events. We have, in
18 the Clerk's Office, have decided that May is the month
19 of celebrating our Mother Earth, so we will have a
20 Native Plant discussion on May 6th from 3:00 to 4:30.
21 Then we will have a Native Plant Sale as a follow-up
22 to that discussion the following Saturday, May 13th.
23 You can pick up a nice plant for your mother that day.

24 Then we're going to have another Native Plant

1 presentation in partnership with the Stagg, Moraine
2 Valley Native Plant Community. Also there will be a
3 plant giveaway in connection with all of the events.
4 So, you know, keep an eye out, come on down, we're
5 going to have some great events.

6 Finally, we're going to have a paper shred
7 event in May, on May 20th, that's Saturday from 9:00
8 to 12:00. So get your Spring cleaning completed at
9 our shred event. That's it.

10 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Is the shred event inside
11 or outside?

12 MS. HOFFENBERG: It's outside in our parking
13 lot.

14 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Very good.

15 Any questions for the Clerk?

16 There being none, thank you.

17 We'll move on to Finance Committee. Trustee
18 Kelly.

19 TRUSTEE KELLY: Thank you, Supervisor. I'd
20 like to entertain a motion for a payment of General
21 Town Fund in the amount of \$174,973.18.

5 roll.

6 MS. HOFFENBERG: Trustee Kelly?

7 TRUSTEE Kelly: Aye.

8 MS. HOFFENBERG: Trustee Crossman?

23 TRUSTEE MCDONALD: Aye.

24 MS. HOFFENBERG: Trustee Anderson?

1 TRUSTEE ANDERSON: Aye.

2 MS. HOFFENBERG: Trustee Crossman?

7 TRUSTEE KELLY: Finally, I would like to
8 entertain a motion for payment to the Special Police
9 Fund in the amount of \$6,480.

10 SUPERVISOR GETTY: We have a motion. Is
11 there a second?

12 TRUSTEE ANDERSON: I'll second that.

13 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Trustee Anderson, thank
14 you.

15 Clerk, please call the roll.

16 MS. HOFFENBERG: Trustee Kelly?

17 TRUSTEE KELLY: Aye.

18 MS. HOFFENBERG: Trustee Anderson?

19 TRUSTEE ANDERSON: Aye.

20 MS. HOFFENBERG: Trustee Crossman?

21 TRUSTEE CROSSMAN: Yes.

22 MS. HOFFENBERG: Trustee McDonald?

23 TRUSTEE MCDONALD: Yes.

24 MS. HOFFENBERG: Supervisor Getty?

1 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Yes.

2 That is approved.

3 TRUSTEE KELLY: That concludes my reports.

4 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Thank you very much,
5 Trustee Kelly.

6 Moving on, we have item 8 on the agenda,
7 Building & Maintenance. Trustee Crossman?

8 TRUSTEE CROSSMAN: March 1st the building
9 went out of power and the power lines went down from
10 ComEd.

11 ComEd was called and they were aware of the
12 outage.

13 And the emergency 24-hour alarm system panels
14 were looked at.

15 Supervisor Getty was called and he was well
16 aware of the situation.

17 Mayor McDermott was called and he sent staff
18 to assist.

19 Power was restored to the building system,
20 and the IT contractors were also contacted, and
21 [tomorrow morning] they evaluated and reset the power
22 systems.

23 March 2nd, ComEd stated that extensive
24 repairs were done to the main line. They had to work

1 on the generator that was in the building. So the
2 power was down three to four hours as the generator
3 was worked on.

4 The IT contractor returned to repair and
5 reset computers and phone lines on March 3rd.

6 Annual Fire Sprinkler System Inspection
7 completed by Pyro Fire Protection, 3/31/2023.

8 An Annual Fire Pump Back Flow Test/Inspection
9 were completed on April 7, 2023, by Terry Plumbing
10 Company.

11 Thank you, Supervisor. That's my report for
12 now.

13 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Thank you, sir.

14 Moving on, we have Senior Transportation,
15 Trustee Kelly.

16 TRUSTEE KELLY: I have no report at this
17 time, Supervisor.

18 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Okay. Thank you very
19 much.

20 We have Committee on Youth, Trustee McDonald.

21 TRUSTEE MCDONALD: I'd like to report on the
22 Summer Intern Program. The hunt for employees is
23 underway. The program is designed to give young
24 individuals an opportunity for summer employment.

1 The program essentially runs from May 30th to
2 September 1st, only June and July and September. The
3 requirements for the program are as follows: The
4 participant must be a resident of Lyons Township, must
5 be between the ages of 16 and 24, and must be
6 attending high school or college.

7 The student will be placed in an agency,
8 village, park district, or other organization with the
9 Township of Lyons.

10 They will receive \$14.05 per hour and will be
11 assigned jobs according to the place of employment.

12 If a student is interested in applying,
13 please contact Mary Van Allen in the supervisor's
14 office.

15 That's all I have to report with.

16 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Thank you, Trustee.

17 We have the Mental Health Commission,
18 Clerk Hoffenberg.

19 MS. HOFFENBERG: I'm going to defer to our
20 director who's present tonight, Ron Melka.

21 MR. MELKA: I just have a few items that I
22 wanted to mention. Our grant applications were all
23 submitted by our currently funded agencies by the
24 deadline at the end of March, and we're in the middle

1 of reviewing those. We will have a Budget Committee
2 meeting as a whole on May 15th where we will determine
3 both our overall annual budget as well as the grant
4 allocations to the agencies. They'll then be
5 presented to our regular -- our rescheduled regular
6 board meeting on May 22nd.

7 Next month is "Aging Well" month. We fund
8 Aging Care Connections for a monthlong educational
9 series of programs throughout the Township. And the
10 catalog of those programs will be in the Tribune this
11 Sunday.

12 The Coalition for a Drug-Free Township is
13 sponsoring "Drug Take Back Day" on April 22nd. Most
14 of the police departments in our community have drug
15 take back boxes. However, LaGrange is doing a special
16 drive and we're providing volunteers there. So we
17 encourage everyone, if they have any drugs or
18 supplements or animal drugs or anything like that, to
19 please return those on April 22nd.

20 And finally, we have a conference, a national
21 conference that's going to be sponsored in the
22 Township Hall on Trauma Inform and Mental Health
23 Justice Summit. We have both virtual and in-person
24 cadre of speakers, nine speakers who will be there

1 over three days, May 17th to 19th, here in the
2 Township Hall. Seating is limited to 80.

3 So we're very happy to sponsor this for the
4 #WeHealUS organization which has set May as a National
5 Mental Health and Trauma month.

6 I want to congratulation Jazmin for all the
7 work that she's done. She's disappeared now.

8 And that concludes my report.

9 MS. HOFFENBERG: Thank you.

10 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Okay. Moving on, we have
11 the Special Police Protection. Trustee Anderson?

12 TRUSTEE ANDERSON: Yes. This is a report
13 from February. We had 15 officers that provided
14 162 hours of contracted patrol for the unincorporated
15 areas of Lyons Township.

16 That concludes my report.

17 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Thank you, sir.

18 Is there any old or new business at this time
19 from the Board?

20 There being none, is there any public
21 comment?

22 Is there a motion to adjourn?

23 TRUSTEE KELLY: Motion to adjourn.

24 TRUSTEE CROSSMAN: Second.

1 SUPERVISOR GETTY: Trustee Kelly, seconded by
2 Trustee Crossman.

3 All those in favor please say "aye."

4 TRUSTEE MEMBERS: (In unison) Aye.
